



## Call for Participants

### Summer School “Beyond the refugee crisis - Studying in Europe”

#### THE FOCUS

The Greek Ministry of Education, Research and Religious Affairs, in cooperation with the Council of Europe and with the participation of the School of Philosophy of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, is organizing the summer school “*Beyond the refugee crisis – Studying in Europe*”. The aim of the Summer School is to facilitate access to university for young refugees who wish to study in Greece or elsewhere in Europe.

Forty (40) students will participate in the summer school. 2/3 of them will be refugees and 1/3 will be peer Greek students. The summer school will take place from 18<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> August 2016. Participants will be hosted in the campus of the International Olympic Academy, in the ancient area of Olympia, in the Peloponnese.

The educational programme includes a series of seminars in European Culture, workshops on language (Greek and English), workshops on human rights and citizenship, as well as presentations/discussions concerning European universities and studies provided. Free time activities (physical and cultural) and one full day excursion are also included in the programme. The courses and activities will be held in English.

The professors and the trainers will be both from Greece and other European countries so that a broad and diverse perspective of Europe, its culture and its system (political and educational) will be presented.

#### HOW TO APPLY

A) Young refugees aged 18-30 currently residing in the area of Attica, who were students when leaving their country of origin, or would like to study in Greece, or elsewhere in Europe, and B) students in Greek universities who would like to act as peer students can apply to participate in the Summer School. Good knowledge of English is a prerequisite. The travel costs and accommodation will be covered by the Ministry.

A certificate of attendance will be awarded to all participants.
